- ▶ The aim of this mobility was to work on an international basis on **Module 3: *What is innovation in agriculture and animal farming?***

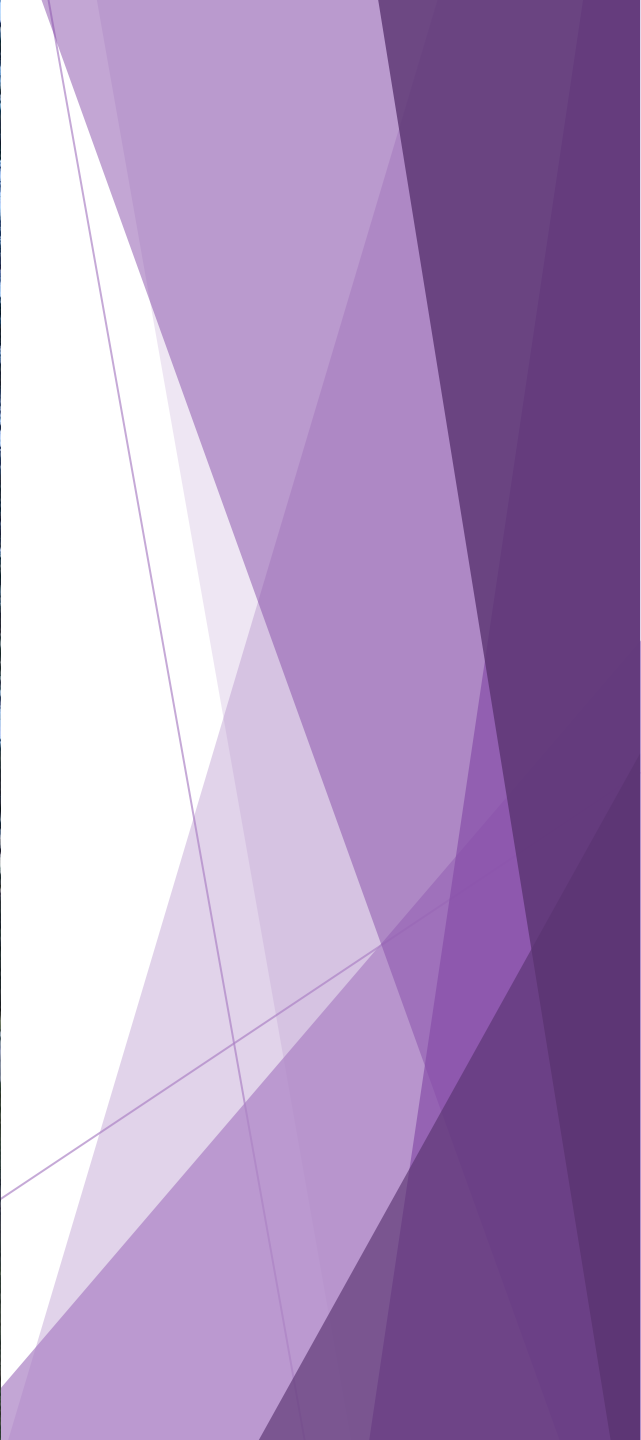
For this reason, international collaboration and exchange of knowledge and practices took part on the following fields:

6. Report of the experiences (oral, written, videos, pictures)

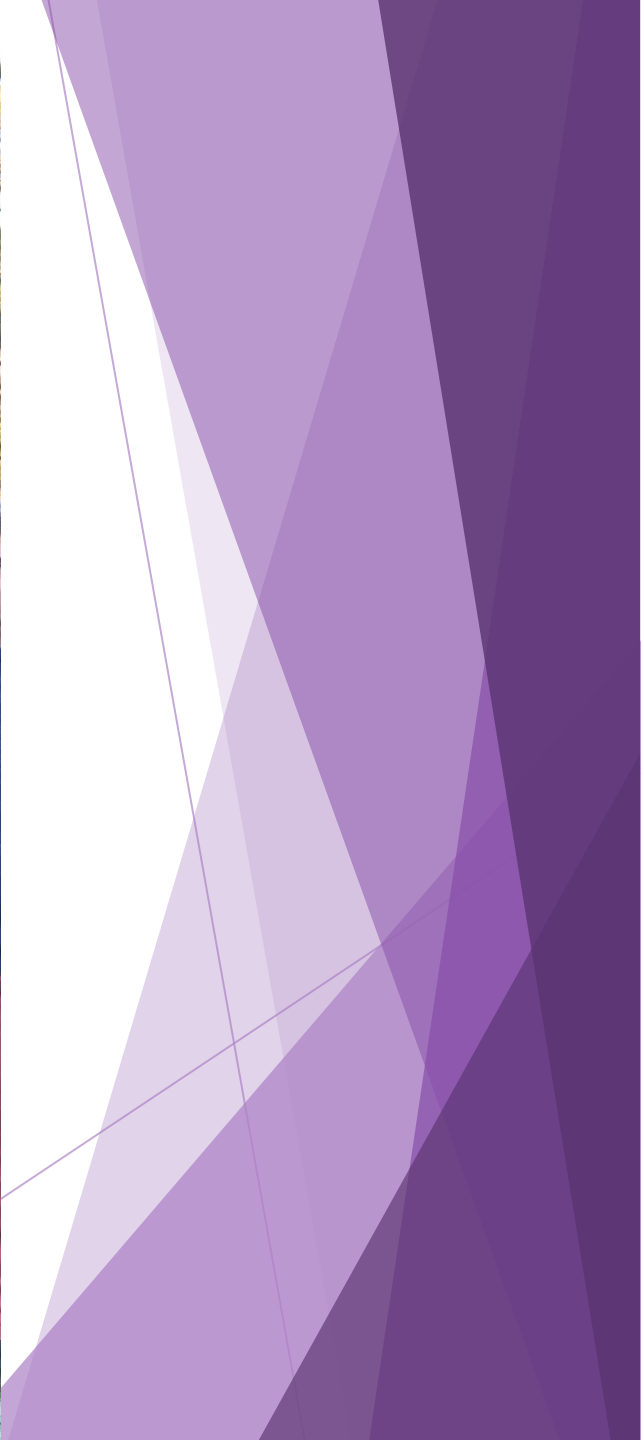
These activities will be carried out outside and in the host school labs.

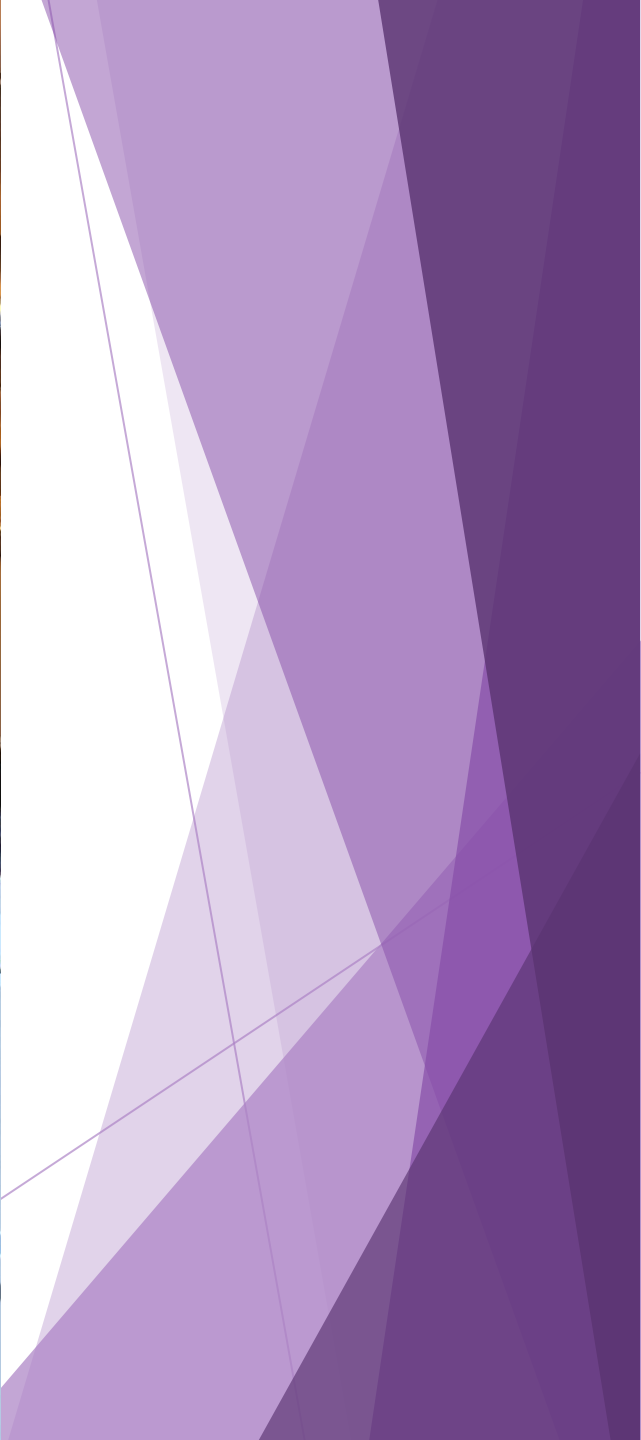

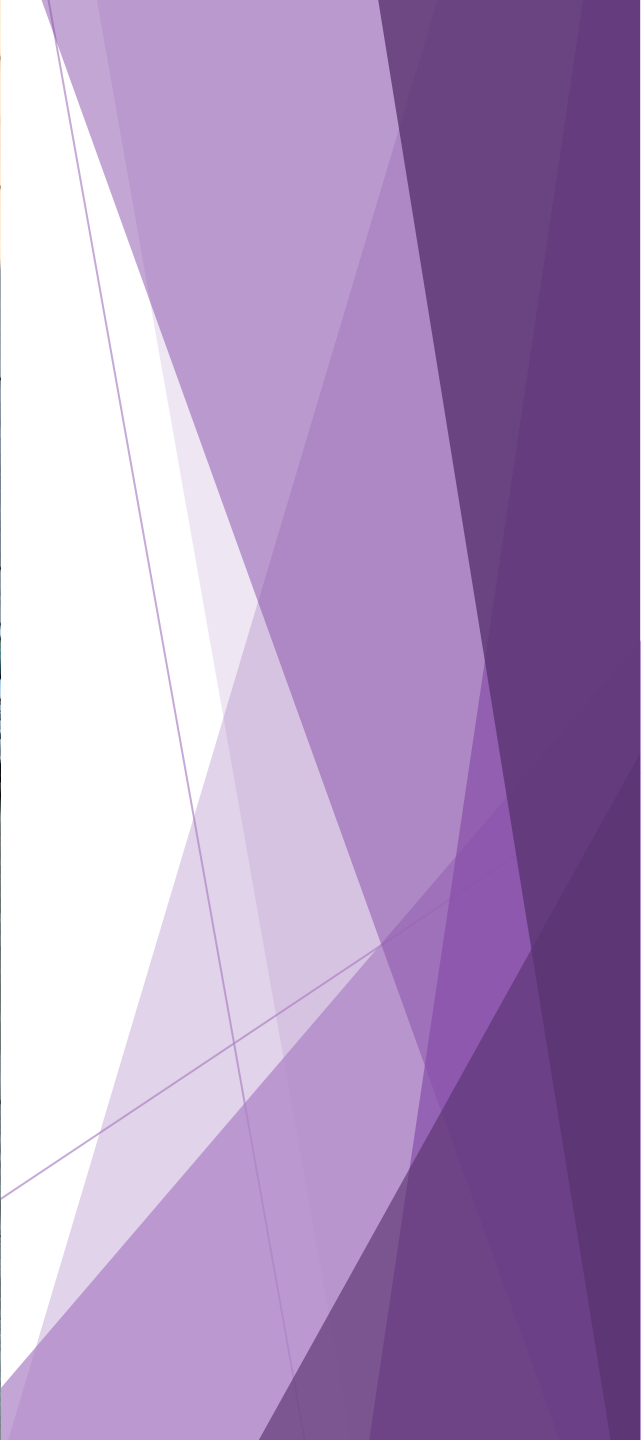














Why do we use the data from the city of Tomelloso?
